Steady Control provides immediate responsiveness to soil conditions with perfectly controlled pressure and uniform tamping. The quality of work is even and homogeneous over the whole field, even at high speed.

The range is enhanced with A NUMBER OF OPTIONS that offer real versatility: the possibility of sowing a cover crop with the SH seeder, various front implements such as the shredder roller or levelling blades and a wide choice of rollers. This makes the OPTIMER stubble cultivator one of the most versatile products on the farm.

Quality of work

In stubble ploughing, the quality of the work is defined by the quantity of uprooted plants, a good soil/straw mulch for rapid decomposition in the soil, the creation of false seedbeds, and a well-levelled and reconsolidated soil.

- Disc arm safety with elastomer blocks on the OPTIMERS to ensure stability and uniform ploughing
- Comb harrow for levelling (optional)
- You have full control of the working depth thanks to ideal ground tracking with the STEADY CONTROL technology

Easy passage

Your stubble cultivator must allow you to cut and bury large volumes of biomass (cover crops, residue, organic amendments).

- OPTIMERS have a large underbeam clearance.
- One disc on each arm for easier passage in plant residue.
- The external disc hub doesn't hinder passage through plant of residue.

Your stubble cultivator must be easy and quick to adjust to save you time on the job without affecting the quality of your work.

- OPTIMERS have simple, hydraulic adjustments.
- To avoid downtime, OPTIMERS are designed with maintenance-free disc and roller bearings.

With the OPTIMERS, a single machine allows you to stubble plough, bury plant residue, create false seedbeds, weed mechanically and prepare the soil before seeding.

In addition, you can stubble plough and seed in one pass with the SH 201, 402 and 600 seed drills. Your cover crop sowing is precise, of high quality and fully autonomous.

- You can reduce costs by using a seed drill in combination with a stubble cultivator.
- Equipping the front hopper with a distribution head lets you broadcast a crop.

Depending on the working depth and the volume of plant residue to be worked, you will choose the model best suited to your working conditions: OPTIMER L with 510 mm diameter discs or OPTIMER XL with 620 mm diameter discs.



510 mm diameter disc on the OPTIMER L:

- Working depth between 3 and 10 cm
- Ideal for surface stubble ploughing

620 mm diameter disc on the OPTIMER XL:

- Large-notched disc
- Working depth between 5 and

Front-end equipment

- The levelling board flattens the ploughed land and breaks up the surface clods.

- The shredder roller makes it easier to pass through heavy plant residue and accelerates their decomposition for a better mineralization.



Sowing implement

To sow your cover crops while stubble ploughing, the OPTIMER XL can be equipped with an SH 201, 402 or 600 seed drill (availability depends on the model).

It can be used to sow cover crops such as mustard, phacelia, clover, ray grass and cereals... in a single pass.



Additional equipment

To fully adapt to your conditions, the OPTIMER range has additional equipment: gauge wheels, rear harrow, additional weights, etc.

A wide range of rollers

The roller plays a key role in providing a clean finish to your stubble ploughing operations. That's why KUHN offers a wide selection of rollers to help you choose the one that best suits your needs. The roller controls the working depth, ensures soil tamping after the discs have passed to keep it cool, levels the ploughed area and crumbles the soil.

CHOOSE BETWEEN OPTIMER L AND XL

The OPTIMERS are divided into two ranges: OPTIMER L with 510 mm diameter discs and OPTIMER XL with 620 mm diameter discs. The L model is the right choice if you are looking for shallow stubble ploughing and soil preparation down to 10 cm. The OPTIMER XL, on the other hand, is more suitable if you want to cut and incorporate heavy residue up to 15 cm deep.

The diameter of the disc directly influences the tillage. Its small diameter generates a high rotation speed, promoting the expansion of the soil.

- Regulates the flow of soil for optimal mixing even during surface tillage;
- Ability to create fine soil tilth for quality false seedbeds;
- Spring preparation: create a fine soil tilth, aerate and warm the soil, even in the presence of residue.



You can make sure your machinery adapts to your working conditions by using front and intermediate equipment on your OPTIMER stubble cultivator. With the OPTIMERS, you can work in a cover crop or in the presence of crop residue (rapeseed, grain corn, manure, etc.), flatten ploughed land, level clods, control soil flow and sow cover crops.





Shredder roller

- Reduction in strand size

Accelerate the decomposition of plant residue

The shredder roller allows you to pass through the cover crop and break up the stems of the plants. Combined with the action of the frost, you get an even better decomposition of the chopped residue. In addition, as the soil is covered with vegetation, you prevent the proliferation of weeds.

The plants, once on the ground, facilitate the passage and the work of the OPTIMER discs.







Gauge wheels

Available on the OPTIMER trailed versions, they allow you to work with the drawbar in the float position for excellent ground tracking and stability. In addition, the working depth is adjusted from the cab via the gauge wheels combined with the roller.



Levelling harrow

The levelling harrow, mounted between the discs and the roller, considerably improves the levelling quality of your field. It guarantees a good distribution of straw and ensures an even soil and residue flow.

Sowing cover crops during ploughing operations saves one pass, which means significant savings in fuel and time. You can choose between a small seed drill attached to your OPTIMER or a TF 1512 kit for greater autonomy.



SH 201 and 402: easy and precise settings

- The dosing unit is driven by an electric motor: very few parts are in motion for a high degree of reliability.
- Depending on the type of seed, the metering rollers can be changed without tools (for small, medium and large seeds).
- Spreaders positioned between the tillage components and the roller ensure an even distribution of the seed over the entire tilled width.



SH 600

- With a capacity of 600 litres, it ensures high work output and low set-up costs. Its Venta distribution guarantees a quality sowing whatever the seed.
- Quick and easy adjustments from the cab:

TF 1512 front hopper

The TF 1512 has a capacity of 2,000 litres and a width of 2.50 metres. It ensures greater autonomy and manoeuvrability.
